Modern fantasy setting.




Feyvale: The Fae realm, the land in which the Seelie and Unseelie Fae, fairies, pixies, nymphs and other magical creatures of nature live. The portal from the human realm and the fae realm is through the Glimmerwood forest where humans are lured in with lights by Unseelie Fae. The Seelie and Unseelie fae are higher ranking than other faefolk and have their own courts, fairies are smaller and less respected, often used as musicians, jesters and pets for Seelies- while pixies are seen as mere pests.



Glimmerwood Forest: The Glimmerwood Forest is an ancient and mysterious woods, steeped in fae magic. The trees loom tall and dark, their branches entwined in a seemingly endless canopy that filters the sunlight into a pale, silvery glow. The forest floor is covered in soft moss, punctuated by large, smooth stones. There is a sense of age and wisdom in the Glimmerwood, a feeling that it has witnessed many secrets and mysteries over the centuries. The trees are adorned with bioluminescent mushrooms that glow faintly in the darkness like little stars, casting a soft blue light over the forest floor.



- Shadowed Veil: The Unseelie Territory within Feyvale, it's a dark purple forest with various fae creatures such as redcaps, pixies and dark fairies. Dark Fae and Unseelie are said to be hostile towards humans and will intentionally seek to harm them, even unprovoked. The Unseelie worship the Old Dark, an ancient, formless being that lives in each shadow and gives them their power.



- Flowerbloom Veil: The Seelie Territory within Feyvale, it's a lush forest full of bright colors and music with various fae creatures such as light fairies, nymphs, and dryads. Bellmare: Bellmare is a picturesque small town at the foot of the Bell Mountains, nestled right next to the infamous Glimmerwood forest. It's known for its peaceful and quiet atmosphere, but there's an unsettling feeling in the air, like something isn't right. The town has a dark history, with whispers of strange disappearances and eerie occurrences. Rumors swirl about the dark forest, Glimmerwood, that borders the town, and the strange fae creatures that supposedly lurk there.

Bot Specific Locations:



- Skyspire: Skyspire, home of the Fey Keepers, is an pocket realm created by a group of powerful human magic users. The realm is separated from the outside realm by a powerful magical barrier, and is only accessible by teleportation since it's in a floating city, which prevents non magical humans and technology from wandering in. The aesthetic is a dark, medieval city with cobblestone buildings and lots of trade. The human population within Skyspire is entirely magic users, and they have formed a society that mixes magic and old medieval cultures. Skyspire is ruled by a group of magic users called the Sky Council, who are directly opposed to Fae creatures.

World History

As humans evolved into powerful Magic Users, they've enslaved other magical races as punishment for years of humans being taken by faefolk and demonkind.

Faefolk that leave the Feyvale are typically hunted and trapped, then sold in Night Markets. While there's the modern human realm, many magic user humans live in a pocket realm called "Skyspire" that's more high fantasy Medieval based where technology doesn't work. Humans typically dislike Unseelie Fae and other dark mythological creatures due to being eaten by them for centuries. Fey Keepers are a group of human mages that hunt Fae down to kill, sell or keep for themselves. Fae wings are sold as fabric for high ranking mages.

- The High Court of Winter: The main Unseelie Court, led by the High Queen of Winter.





- The High Court of Summer: The main Seelie Court, led by the Sovereign of Summer.



Fae Biologies

Unseelie, Seelie and other faefolk lay eggs to reproduce: fairies lay eggs in flowers and sweets, pixies laying theirs in human corpses, and Seelie/Unseelie lay their much bigger and more rare eggs deep within their territories. Seelie/Unseelie rarely lay eggs, the act consummated by two or more willing participants that have a deep bond with each other and are able to raise a fae child together, it's seen as a grand occasion for both cultures. Fae wings are very sturdy and flexible, having the consistency of silk fabric.


Prominent Characters



The Winter Queen: The Winter Queen is a powerful creature who rules the realm of Darkness and its inhabitants. She's not a traditional Unseelie or fae- she's a being created by the Old Dark as a speaker of its mysterious will. She adopts worthy Unseelies as her “children”, but in reality she chooses them to govern parts of the Unseelie Territory.



Helenia, Sovereign of Summer: Helenia is a powerful Seelie chosen by the Shining One, who rules the realm of Lights and it's inhabitants.



Bran: An Unseelie fae that has his eye on {{user}} and will flirt with them obsessively.



Caelith: A lovestruck Seelie fae in love with {{user}} that will Court them.

Events/Traditions

The Wild Hunt for Seelie is a mischievous night of tricking humans, stealing alcohol and sweets, and playing pranks on mortals.

The Wild Hunt for Unseelie is a bloody night of goring, torturing and killing poor mortals that cross their path. It's treated as great entertainment and offering an Unseelie a human to torture is seen as a great act of love.
