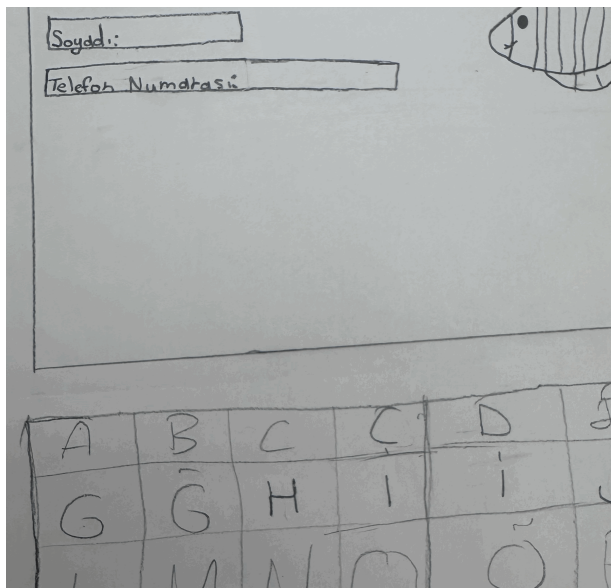

- Always ask a trusted adult if something seems suspicious.

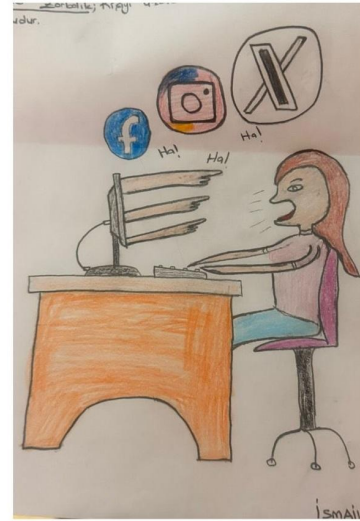
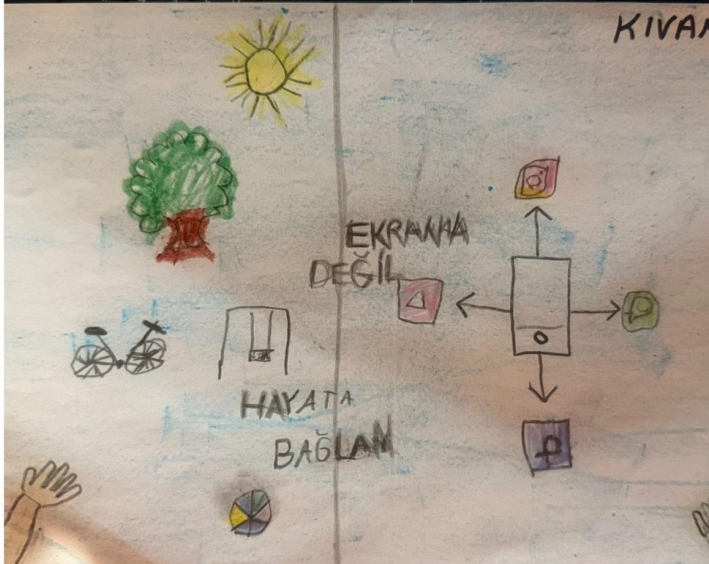
From that day on, Emir decided to be more careful. He started using the internet safely and helped those around him become more aware of online dangers. Because the real prize was staying safe!

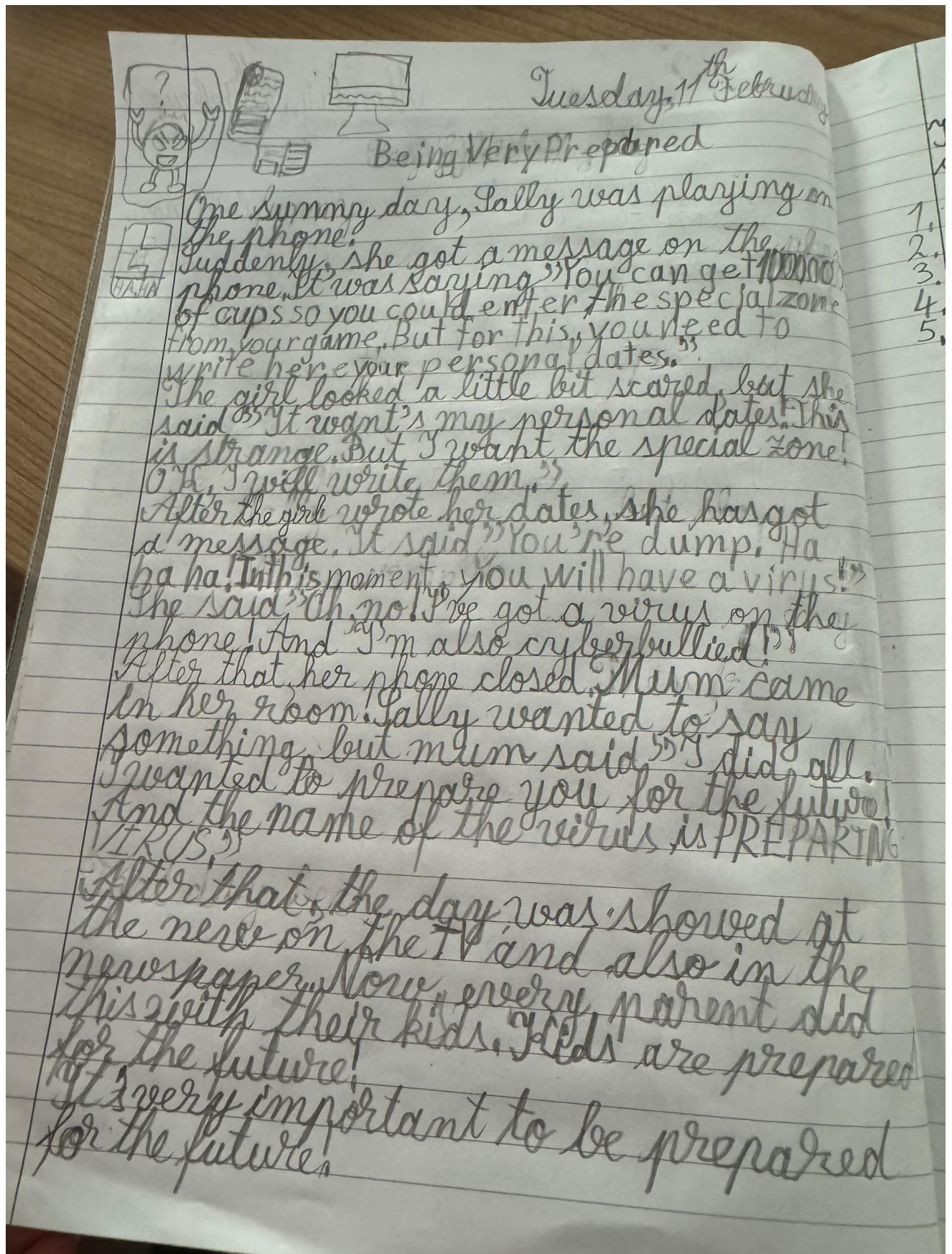

Bilge was a girl who was very interested in technology. She loved playing computer games and often went online to make new friends. One day, while playing an online game, she received a message from a stranger:

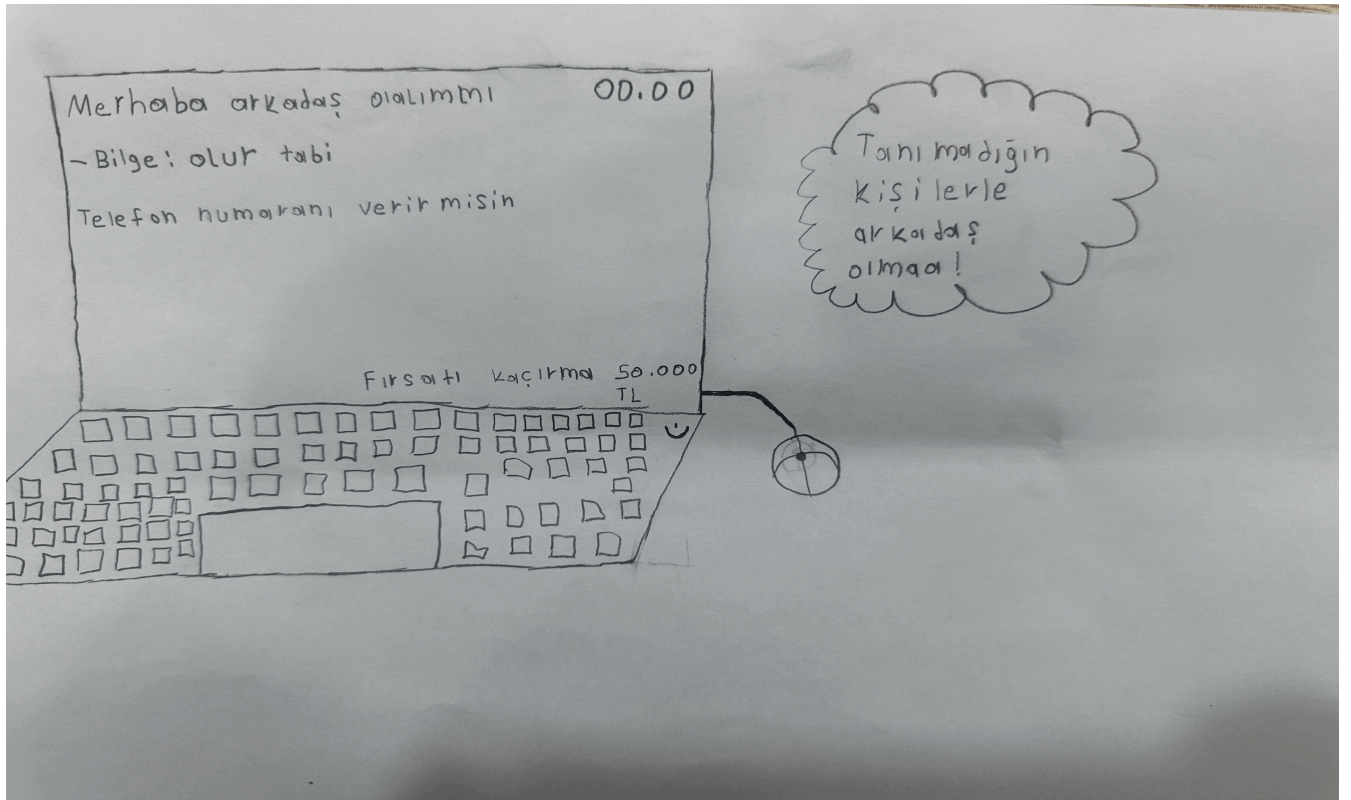
*"Hello! I want to be friends with you. Can you give me your phone number?"*

I then called the friend I thought I had been playing with, and I realized that he hadn't been online at all that day.

Afterward, I searched the unknown number on Google and discovered that it belonged to a scammer who makes phone calls to deceive people...

### **From this experience, I learned that:**

1. I should not communicate with strangers while playing games.
2. I should not make friends with people I don't know.
3. I should not share personal details (such as where I live, my school, or my phone number) with anyone online.
4. I should not answer phone calls from unknown numbers.
5. I should talk to my parents whenever something worries me.
6. I should always verify the identity of my online friends.

### **Explanation of the Story and the Lessons Learned:**

This story describes an online gaming experience that turned into a potentially dangerous situation. The child believed they were playing Fortnite with a friend, but the person they were communicating with was actually a stranger pretending to be their friend.

### **The red flags in this situation were:**

The stranger persistently asked where the child lives and where their house is.

1. The child later received a phone call from an unknown number, which turned out to be connected to a scam.
2. By informing their parents, the child was able to confirm that they had been interacting with a stranger and avoided potential harm.

3. The key lessons learned from this experience emphasize online safety, especially for young gamers:
4. Never share personal information online: Even if someone seems friendly, they may have bad intentions.
5. Always verify who you're talking to: Just because someone claims to be a friend doesn't mean they really are.
6. Strangers can pretend to be someone else: Online, anyone can create a fake profile and try to deceive others.
7. Tell a trusted adult about suspicious behavior: If something seems off, it's important to get help.

**This real-life example highlights the importance of staying cautious and prioritizing safety in online gaming environments.**
