Diboll ISD voters approved the Diboll ISD \$12 million bond proposition during the November 4, 2025, election. With nearly 56% of voter approval, the bond funds will focus on improvements needed at the junior high and other DISD facility needs.

During a special meeting on August 4, Diboll ISD's Board of Trustees voted unanimously to call a \$12 million bond election for the November 4, 2025 ballot. Parents, teachers, staff, students, and community members met several times over the summer of 2025. They toured and reviewed the district's current facilities and discussed academic priorities with district administration. The committee identified needs and developed a recommendation for the Board, presented on August 4, 2025. The District's Facility Advisory Committee, representing a cross-section of the community, played a key role in this decision. Parents, teachers, staff, students, and community members shared their unique perspectives as the committee identified needs and developed a recommendation for the Board.

"I sincerely appreciate the service of the District's Facility Advisory Committee and Board of Trustees in identifying the district's needs and potential solutions," Dr. Gusyakov said.
