

ADUE Policy re: GSI:Class Size

As part of the GEO contract Article XVII Class Size, "Each department employing GSIs will establish a class size policy for classes to which GSIs are assigned. This class size policy will include, but need not be limited to, the maximum number of students in each section (recognizing the potential for reduction within sections with regard to programmatic need) and the maximum ratio of students to GSIs. The class size policy will be provided to any Employee upon request."

Additional notes: A first-time ENGR 100 instructor may make a request for an additional GSI.
