ANNOUNCEMENTS:

<u>Construction on Hughes Road:</u> Next Week, Construction holdups on Hughes Road will last up to 20minutes. This project will continue for approximately another month. To avoid delays, use Sierra College Drive and avoid Hughes Road.

Chromebooks:

- Bring Chromebooks charged every day for classroom instruction.
- Loaner Chromebooks will only be given to students with Chromebook repairs.
- Loaners will not be given to students who forgot their Chromebook at home or do not have a charged Chromebook.

Student with Open Periods:

- Open periods are only given to Juniors and Seniors by request who are on track for Graduation.
- Students with Open periods are for those going to work, taking Sierra College classes, etc.
- The *expectation* is that students with Open periods leave campus after their last scheduled class.
- Students with Open periods are not allowed to stay on campus for safety purposes. We cannot account for students who are not enrolled in classes. During an emergency, we can only account for students who are assigned a class. So these students cannot sit in another teacher's class, the Library, or roam around campus.
- An open period is a privilege. If students are not leaving campus during their open period, we will enroll them in a class to ensure they are accounted for.

Student Meals:

ALL students will receive FREE meals through the National School Breakfast and Lunch Programs. We ask that all families submit meal applications so we are able to continue to participate in this program and provide this service.
