Project Description: Woolery Ditch diversion structure rebuild

Reason for Project: Friends of the Yampa has been working with the owners of the Woolery Ditch to prepare for a structural project that would rectify the need to build a push up dam for the ditch every few years. Location would be optimal for an agricultural/recreational partnership as diversion structure would be built to accommodate both attributes. For the cost estimate, it was assumed that the headgate had a max capacity of 33 cfs and only the diversion dam was rebuilt. The costing tool was used for this estimate.
