Subscale	Mark	Commentary
<i>Content</i>	2/5	The student answers the question and expresses an opinion, but the essay does not fully develop the required notes. The point about people's appearance is mentioned, but the discussion of the price of clothes is very limited. The third idea is unclear, and some arguments are difficult to follow. The essay is also under the word limit.
<i>Communicative Achievement</i>	2/5	The text has the basic structure of an essay (introduction and conclusion), but the ideas are not presented clearly enough to persuade the reader. The register is generally appropriate, although many awkward expressions reduce the overall effectiveness.
<i>Organisation</i>	2/5	The essay is written as one long paragraph. A clear introduction, body paragraphs, and conclusion are expected. Some linking words ("for instance", "perhaps", "even so", "in summary") are used, but they are sometimes used incorrectly or do not connect ideas logically.
<i>Language</i>	1/5	There are frequent grammatical errors (verb forms, articles, prepositions, word order, sentence structure, spelling, and punctuation). Vocabulary shows some ambition ("indicator in the economy", "global impact"), but incorrect collocations and grammar often make the meaning difficult to understand.

Subscale	Mark	Commentary
<i>Content</i>	3/5	The article answers both questions: when the student listens to music and how they choose music for different situations. However, the ideas are not always fully explained, and some examples are difficult to understand because of language errors.
<i>Communicative Achievement</i>	2/5	The writer attempts to write an article by addressing the reader directly and ending with an encouraging message. However, the style is inconsistent, and the article lacks an engaging introduction and conclusion that would interest readers of a website.
<i>Organisation</i>	2/5	The article consists of one long paragraph. Ideas are presented in a logical order, but paragraphing is missing. Some linking words are used ("For instance", "otherwise", "Due to"), but transitions are sometimes awkward or inaccurate.
<i>Language</i>	2/5	There is enough vocabulary to communicate the main ideas, but there are many grammar mistakes involving verb forms, articles, prepositions, collocations, and sentence structure. These errors sometimes make the meaning unclear, although communication is generally maintained.
