



EXECUTIVE ORDER 032

ENFORCING GENDER EQUALITY WITH REGARDS TO TOPLESSNESS

WHEREAS, the 28th Amendment outlaws discrimination based on sex.

WHEREAS, the act of being topless is often considered acceptable for men, but unacceptable or even illegal for women.

I. DEFINITIONS.

- (a) Toplessness shall be defined as wearing no clothing on the body's torso or chest.

II. PROHIBITING ARRESTS ON ACCOUNT OF TOPLESSNESS.

- (a) Any State agent, State police officer, municipal police officer, or any other individual working for the State, a county, or a municipal government is hereby prohibited from arresting or charging a person on account of their toplessness.

III. PRIOR EXECUTIVE ORDERS

This Executive Order supersedes any contrary provision of any other prior Executive Order.
