Adam & Eve Disobey God
Genesis 3

In today's lesson, your child learned that **Jesus Came to Save Sinners!**

Adam and Eve lived in a beautiful garden where they got to spend time with God. Adam and Eve had healthy hearts that loved and trusted God.

The garden had lots of yummy food to eat. God told Adam and Eve that they could eat the fruit from ALL of the trees except one tree. God's rule was good and kept Adam and Eve safe.

One day a sneaky snake lied to Adam and Eve. The snake said they should eat the fruit God told them not to eat. Adam and Eve listened to the snake instead of listening to God.

Adam and Eve ate the fruit from the tree they were not supposed to eat from. Adam and Eve were scared because they had done something wrong.
