II. Principal's update

A. VLS and in-person numbers: 152 VLS; 369 in-person. Dr. Duke hopes to have teacher assignments out by next week. All students in DL (3-5), in-person (K-2), or VLS start with their new teacher on Mon 2/1. Teachers will reach out to families to introduce themselves to the new class the week of Mon 1/25.

Art instruction with Courtney Oleen has begun. She's been joining some classroom morning meetings. Mon 2/1, art instruction will be in-person. Virtual classes are TBD.

Art, Science, and Music specialist instruction will occur in the main student classroom. Phy Ed will be held in the gym. Specialists will teach to in-person and VLS students. Services like ELL and speech therapy will continued to be offered by current instructors to in-person and VLS students.

There will be a new attendance policy once in-person starts, for example: a student in in-person learning is staying home due to a cough or quarantine, the student, if well to participate in learning, can be tracked as present versus absent and participate in lessons that teacher will post online.
