In groups of 2, you will be responsible to create a Presentation on a given economic philosopher. For the presentation, you need to look at three sources minimum to find your information (individually). I will provide you one resource from the text that you should use. You need to develop an organizer to record your research points and must show cross referencing. Using the information from your organizer, your group will create a Google Slide Show on your philosopher that will meet the above Learning Goals and Success Criteria. Each member is required to make and put their name on the slides that they will present.

After you have finished developing the Presentation, each individual in the group will have to write a minimum of a one-page summary of the presentation. Ensure that you include all the major points of your presentation.
