Wait until after May 4th due to primaries

Attached are lists of the House & Senate Health Committee Members. I omitted 2 legislators who are retiring and will not be back in 2027. Additionally, a number of these legislators have primaries and *could* be defeated in May or November. And then after every 2-year election cycle, members are assigned to committees and there could be new members, although most of the current committee members will likely be reappointed. I won't have the final 2027 committee rosters until sometime in late November.

I listed the counties each legislator represents, not their hometown. I thought that we would have a better chance of finding a "key contact" if we looked at their entire district, not just their hometown.

To start, I suggest focusing on the republican legislators as republicans hold supermajorities in both houses and completely control the agenda.
