Researchers found that investors with larger accounts follow more contrarian strategies, reflect the news in their trades, and experience subsequent gains, while smaller accounts tend to follow momentum-based strategies, fail to account for the news when placing trades, and incur trading losses. They also found that these trends were stronger for younger men. The study's authors found that all groups of individual investors lose money, though individual investors with larger account sizes lose significantly less on average (Source: AAII Journal, August 2020). Another study found that investors with a high level of financial literacy take too many risks, overborrow, and hold naive financial attitudes. However, this high level of financial literacy also lends itself to better retirement planning, since people with more financial literacy are more likely to have a retirement savings plan. In addition, financially literate households earn higher financial returns than illiterate ones. (Source: AAII Journal, August 2020).
