The NYCUDL is a nonprofit that exists to support the growth and development of competitive debate programs in the greater New York City area, with priority emphasis given to schools with a large percentage of students of color and low-resourced students.

The New York City Urban Debate League (NYCUDL) is seeking an experienced and dedicated Debate Coach to join our NYCUDL-Wake Forest Dream Team. This team represents the best students from NYCUDL, providing them with opportunities to compete at national debate tournaments.

Job Responsibilities

- Coach and mentor students in Lincoln-Douglas (LD) or Policy debate, preparing them for national circuit competitions.
- Travel with students to national debate tournaments, serving as a chaperone and coach (4-5 weekends per semester).
- Judge debates at tournaments as required.
- Assist in coordinating travel logistics, including driving if necessary.

Qualifications

- Must be 21 years of age or older.
- Bachelor's degree required.
- Experience in national circuit LD or Policy debate.
- Willingness to travel and chaperone students during weekends.
- Prior experience chaperoning students is preferred.
- Valid driver's license and ability to drive if needed.
- Familiarity with tabroom.com and other debate tabulation/registration processes.

Other Requirements

- Legal clearance to work with minors.
- Must pass a background check.
- Strong ethics, maturity, and appropriate boundaries for adult interactions with minors.
- NYC area preferred
