

Grouping Guide

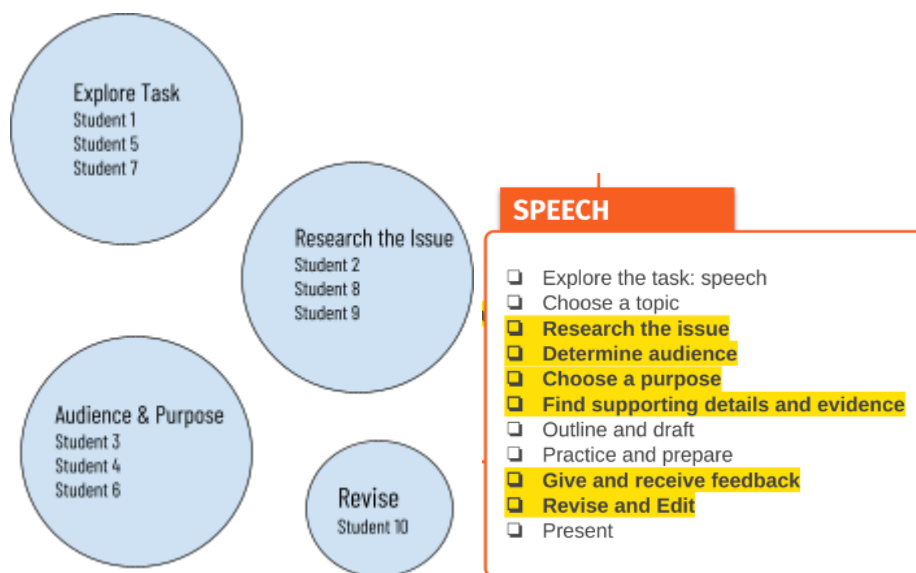
This is the 2nd step in **personalizing** learning in your classroom. If you have not conferenced or gathered data, do that before grouping. Once you have your data, examine and you will start to see categories emerge. There are several ways you can group. Begin by getting curious about the data you are seeing. You might need more data to move into grouping.

- Where are they on the studio pathway?
- How are they doing with each skill?
- How are their mindsets toward this activity/task/product?
- What do they need right now?

The more specific you can be on where they are, the easier step 3, planning, will be.

Example:

"I have conferenced with each learner and know where they are on the pathway. I look at each learner and see what they need. I ask myself, "what common needs am I seeing?"



Now that you have groups, you can plan for their next steps!
