## Sub: Compliance with directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in its judgment dated September 26, 2018 in W.P.(C) No. 494 of 2012 and connected matters

Dear Sir/Ma'am,

- 1. I am [insert brief introduction of the signatory and their association with the Aadhaar matter/program.] The Supreme Court's final order and judgment was pronounced in the above-referenced batch of petitions on 26.09.2018 (the "Judgement").
- 2. With this letter, I would like to bring to your notice that in demanding Aadhaar for services your organisation [name] is failing to comply with the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court. I request you to take all necessary steps to ensure that this is rectified immediately in the interests of compliance with the Supreme Court's judgement, and in the interests of the basic and fundamental rights of children to education and privacy.
- 3. As you may be aware, the Hon'ble Supreme Court's Judgment significantly restricted the mandatory use of Aadhaar.
- 5. It has been brought to my attention that your organisation is asking people to provide their Aadhaar number. This is in contempt of the Hon'ble Supreme Court's judgment, which held unanimously that it was unconstitutional to require Aadhaar numbers for anything other than subsidies or benefits funded from the Consolidated Fund of India.
- 6. In view of the aforesaid, I request that your organisation take immediate steps to ensure that:
  - (i) Aadhaar numbers are not linked to the provision of any goods or services;
  - (ii) Your organisation doesn't ask for, use or retain my Aadhaar number, or link it to any other database;
  - (iii) Immediately delete or modify all extant records to remove all Aadhaar-related data.
