

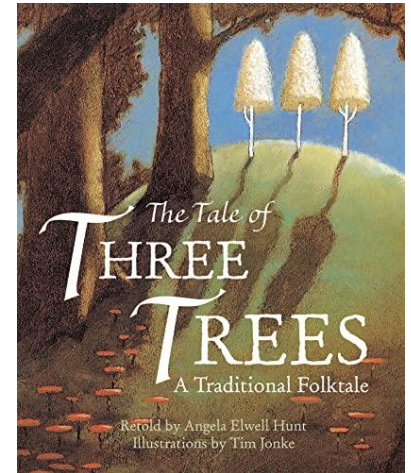
“The Tale of Three Trees”
