Self-revision checklist, part II

MLA general guidelines
Typed
Double-space the text of your paper, using a 12 point font in which the regular and italicized
font are distinguishable.
Leave only one space after periods or other punctuation marks.
Set the margins of your document to 1 inch on all sides.
Indent the first line of paragraphs one half-inch from the left margin. MLA recommends that
you use the Tab key as opposed to pushing the Space Bar five times.
Create a header that numbers all pages consecutively in the upper right-hand corner,
one-half inch from the top and flush with the right margin.
Use italics throughout your essay for the titles of longer works and, only when absolutely
necessary, providing emphasis.
center your title
works cited should start on a new page, with a centered title: Works Cited. Entries should
be in the appropriate form for the source, and reverse indented (see sample paper link
