
2025 Sub-State 1 American Legion Baseball Tournament at Owatonna



1. 10 teams in the league tournament for 2025

- 2. All teams will play each other once in league play.
- 3. A daily pitch count limit of 105 pitches will be enforced for each game during the regular season. A pitcher may finish the batter if that limit is reached during an at-bat.
- 4. At the sub-state tournament, the pitch count limits as set by the National Rule Book will be enforced. Host site is responsible for tracking pitch counts each game.
- 5. Makeup games should be rescheduled as soon as possible. Too many rescheduled games late in the season might mean too many games in a short period of time and may result in forfeits. Forfeits deprive the opponent of a game and may also have an effect on the final standings for some teams.
- 6. For playoffs, the top five teams will draw a bye while the other six teams will play a single elimination pigtail game on Friday, July 18 at high seeds which will be determined by final league standings.
- 7. Ties in league standings will be broken by the following:
 - 1. Head-to-Head competition
 - 2. Record against teams in their tied group
 - 3. Record against teams above them in the standings
 - 4. Least runs allowed in head-to-head
 - 5. Least runs allowed in tied group
 - 6. Least runs allowed against teams above them in the standings.
 - 7. Coin flip
- 8. In a tie for position with three or more teams; after one team is seeded, the criteria procedure starts over for the remaining teams and does so each time a tie is broken.
- 9. Eight teams will participate in a double elimination tournament with first round games played on Sunday, July 20 at the four highest seeds. Games will be played at high seeds until we reach the host site on Friday.
- 10. Friday games in the double elimination, and all remaining games, will be played at Dartt's Park in Owatonna on July 25 and 26.
- 11. The highest seeded team is the home team unless a lower seeded team is the lone undefeated team, then that team is the home team. And any time a team plays a team that they defeated in their previous meeting, they are the home team.
- 12. Each team in the league will pay a \$100 league fee to Owatonna before the season begins.
- 13. Ticket prices are \$5.00 for adults (day pass). Free for high school age and under. Pigtail and first round hosts may charge whatever they wish for those games.
