What do I do now that I've signed up to host a JMC Toy Drive?

How long will my JMC Toy Drive last?

Your JMC Toy Drive must conclude by December 16th. Other than that, you may set the start and end dates that are best for your organization.

What does JMC do to support my JMC Toy Drive?

For all that host a JMC Toy Drive, JMC will provide a general information poster, a Jimmy Murphey's Christmas collection box for participants to place their donations, a general info JMC Yard Sign and a general info JMC window cling.

Who will receive a toy?

Guests in need come to Living Water a Church of God Fellowship on Saturday, December 21st. Those that have children ages birth-14 in their home, will get the opportunity to shop the "JMC Toy Store" to pick out a toy for their child(ren).

What toys should people donate to our JMC Toy Drive?

JMC does not create a list of toyAll toys must be UNWRAPPPED, new and in box or with tagss to donate. If such a list were created, most would follow it, resulting in a limited selection of items in our JMC Toy Store. We encourage individuals to purchase items they would like, themselves OR items that are within their budget.

What toys should people <u>NOT</u> donate to our JMC Toy Drive?

Items NOT to donate are: anything edible, used or damaged items, any war-related items such as toy guns, knives, etc., glass items such as snow globes or glass containers, anything aerosol or spray (like silly string), and Gift Cards.
