THE GREENIE JACKSON/NHS SCHOLARSHIP - 2025

The Greenwood High School National Honor Society will sponsor the Greenie Jackson Memorial Scholarship, a grant that will be a minimum of \$200.

History:

The scholarship is presented in honor of Mr. Greenie Jackson, a long time science teacher and NHS advisor at Greenwood High School.

Eligibility:

Any senior who is a member of the Greenwood NHS is eligible to apply for this scholarship award.

Criteria:

To qualify, the applicant must type a report, not to exceed two pages, double spaced with one inch margins all around. The essay should discuss why scholarship, leadership, service, and character are requirements for admission into the National Honor Society.

The second part of this essay should describe how these characteristics and the National Honor Society have impacted you and helped you grow as a person.

The selection committee, in addition to the content of your essay, will take into account correct spelling, sentence structure, grammar and punctuation.

The final portion of your essay should include the technical college or university you plan to attend and the avenue of study you plan to pursue (if you have decided). This portion of your essay should be very brief.
