Advanced Digital Photography

This course of instruction is designed for those students interested in the techniques applied to the field of digital photography. Instruction is given in visual awareness, the fundamentals of design, layout, composition, and basic camera functions. Students will become familiar with manipulating photo images after taking pictures with an SLR digital camera. The primary program for this class will be **Photoshop CS6** though others may be explored.

Prerequisites

Art I or Drawing I, and permission of the instructor. (Students may be asked to purchase additional supplies for this course)

I. Scope of curriculum

Students will begin with basic exercises in using a DSLR camera and other types of digital cameras. All equipment will be provided during this class however bringing your own digital camera is acceptable (you will be responsible for your own camera if you bring it in).
