Benefits of District Zoom Accounts for Students

All CISD students have access to a District Zoom Account. Following are some of the benefit of a district account:

- It is a managed account by CISD Technology.
- Students cannot start their own meetings; They can only join meetings.
- When teachers start a meeting it defaults to CISD accounts only, unless a teacher changes this setting to allow an outside presenter to join the meeting.

- Select the Zoom application
- Click Sign in to configure your account
- Students will be redirected to their Zoom Profile page

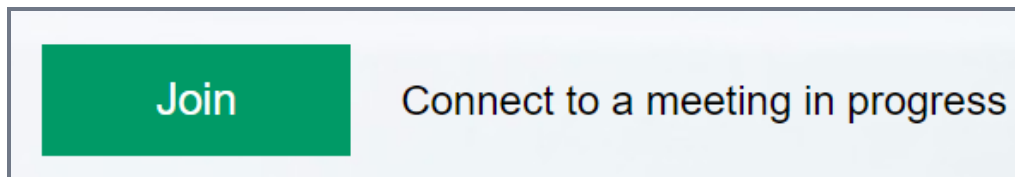

- Students will click the meeting link sent by their teacher and automatically connect to the meeting.

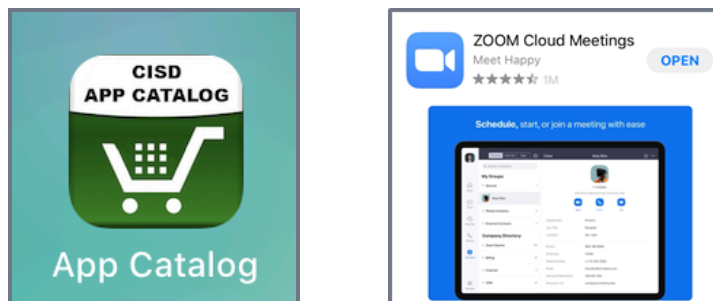
OR

- Click Join- Connect to a meeting in Progress from the [Zoom application page](#) > Type in the Meeting ID.

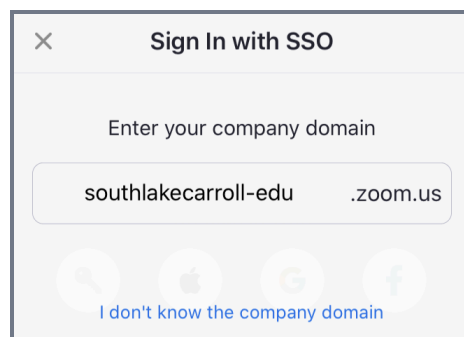
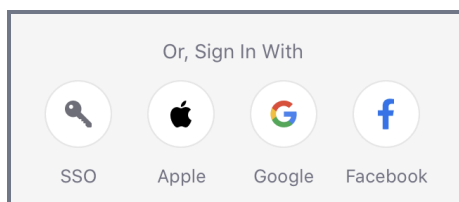


iPad- How to Sign in to Zoom

- On a district issued iPad, visit the CISD App Catalog
- Select the Zoom Meetings App

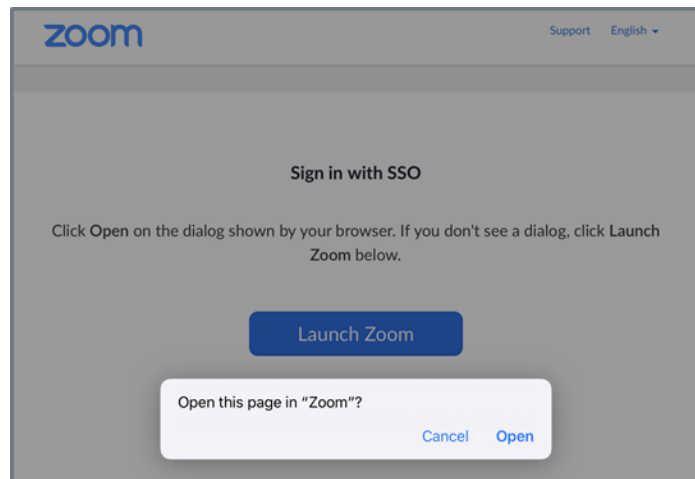


- On a personal device, visit the App Store
- Tap Sign in with SSO
- Students will enter the company domain as **southlakecarroll-edu** and select **Go** on their keyboard.



iPad- How to Sign in to Zoom

- Select “Open”



- The iPad will then launch the Zoom app and be logged into the student account.
- If your student is not already logged into their Google account when they click open, they will then be prompted to sign-in to their Google account.
