VI. Old Business

- a. February Fundraisers
 - i. Hoagie Sale – Lisa and Jason Haskins
 - ii. Not being a trip year, we are seeing fewer and fewer hoagies sold
 - iii. Last hoagie sale: April 2023.
 - 1. If we can get 8th graders to fund raise, it could be good.
 - 2. If not, then we're all tired of selling things.
 - iv. Eileen: Alternative suggestion – solicited Rita's Italian Ice
 - 1. Fundraising card
 - 2. There was discussion over the amount of cards that needed to be purchased ahead of the fundraiser – 50 vs. 100.
 - 3. Cards to be sold at \$5.00 each for 10% off each time you go – it's good all summer long at any Rita's location; NOT good on the big ices
 - 4. Melissa Allenbaugh volunteered to chair this fundraiser.
 - v. Lisa Haskins – can sell the cards at the concession stand on 3/25 and 3/26
 - vi. Lisa started looking into other hoagie suppliers
 - 1. Benefit of Galiffa's – lettuce/tomato packed separately
 - 2. Triangle – everything is put together on the hoagies; better return
 - 3. Marianna's - \$3.00 per hoagie; everything is separated. Order online. 14" vs. 12"
 - 4. No delivery fee for any of the alternative hoagie vendors
 - 5. Will explore a different hoagie vendor for the April hoagie fundraiser

VII. New Business

- a. March Fundraisers
 - i. Pepperoni Roll Fundraiser – Chairs: Missy and Ron Perris
 - 1. Pepperoni Roll Pick Up: Tuesday, March 21 4:00-5:30 pm at Missy and Ron's House
 - 2. All sales were small this year
 - ii. Annual Spaghetti Dinner Fundraiser – Saturday, March 18, 2023
 - 1. Lots of help is still needed!
 - 2. Close to 280 tickets sold, still have some people who will give Eileen ticket money, plus some tickets from this afternoon – probably around 300 tickets sold
 - a. For students who have not purchased tickets or returned their tickets, Eileen sent an email on 3/13 with 3/14 due date

3. Placemat Ads – we are up to 3 different placemats because we’ve had so many donors place ads.
4. Baskets – will get them together this evening
5. 50/50 planned – should go over well at this event
6. Thank you to everyone who has been involved with getting ads and basket contributions
7. Theatre boosters are not paying for the spaghetti dinners for the kids participating in the musical.
 - a. Last year was a \$600 donation from Lauren Krupp for the kids in the musical to have a free spaghetti dinner.
8. Eileen would like to buy the tickets for the directors – Eileen has 6 tickets sold that aren’t being used. If anyone has any tix that were purchased and not going to be used, we will use them for the directors.
 - a. Susan Reed will donate her 4 tickets; Katrina Wehring will donate her 4 tickets; Kelly Bandik will donate her 3 extra tickets
9. We still need volunteers for the Spaghetti dinner.
 - a. Sign Up Genius is active on tjband.com
- iii. Lottery Ticket Fundraiser – Kelly Bandik
 1. March 9, 2023-Ticket sales start
 2. Drawing: Sunday, April 9, 2023
 3. Tickets are \$10 each for two 3-digit lottery numbers
 4. Have sold 225 out of 500 at this point
 5. Lisa Hopkins – can we sell lottery tickets at the spaghetti dinner?
 - a. There was discussion around how the profits would be shared if decision was made to sell lottery tickets at the spaghetti dinner.
 - b. Can advertise the lottery tickets at the spaghetti dinner
