09:00-10:00 **Meeting with Mr. Lu Hao, First Secretary, Secretariat of Central Committee of Communist Youth League of China**

Mr. Lu Hao worked as Assistant to the Factory Director, Vice Factory Director, Factory Director and Vice Party Secretary of Beijing Woolen Textile Manufacturing Factory; Member of the CPC Committee, Director of the Board and Vice General Manager of the Beijing Textile Holding (Group) Company Limited; Vice Chairman, Chairman, Secretary of Party Group of the Management Committee of Zhongguancun Science and Technology Park, Vice Party Secretary of the CPC Haidian District Committee; Vice Mayor of Beijing Municipality, Member of Party Leadership Group of the Beijing Municipal Government, Party Secretary of the Industry Work Committee of the CPC Beijing Committee, Chairman of the Beijing Economic Commission. In September 2003, he assumed the position of Vice Mayor of Beijing. His responsibilities and duties include government work related to commerce, industry and foreign affairs, etc.

He became the First Secretary of Secretariat of Central Committee of the Communist Youth League of China in late April, 2008.

Communist Youth League of China

A mass organization of advanced youth, the Communist Youth League of China is a school for young people to learn socialism with Chinese characteristics and communism in practice and an assistant and reserve force for the Communist Party of China.

10:30-11:30 **Meeting with Mr. Yao Gang, Vice Chairman of China Securities Regulatory Commission**

Mr. Yao Gang was appointed Vice Chairman of CSRC in 2008. Prior to this position, he was Assistant Chairman and was responsible for the supervision of domestic public offering of securities. He was Director-General of the CSRC Public Offering Supervision Department from May 2002 To August 2004. Mr. Yao Gang joined the CSRC as Deputy Director-General of the Futures Supervision Department in 1993. In 1997, he was promoted to the position of Director-General of the same Department. Between 1999 and 2002, he was President of the Guotai Junan Securities Company, Ltd. (GTJA). Mr. Yao Gang obtained his M.A. in

Sociology from the University of Tokyo, Japan in 1989 and received a Ph.D in Economics by Wuhan University, China in 1999. Mr. Yao Gang was born on 24 May 1962, in Shanxi Province, China.

China Securities Regulatory Commission (CSRC)

The SCSC is a centralized securities supervisory system with the following functions:

1. To establish a centralized supervisory system for securities and futures markets and to assume direct leadership over securities and futures market supervisory bodies.
2. To strengthen the supervision over securities and futures business, stock and futures exchange markets, the listed companies, fund management companies investing in the securities, securities and futures investment consulting firms, and other intermediaries involved in the securities and futures business. To raise the standard of information disclosure.
3. To increase the abilities to prevent and handle financial crisis.
4. To organize the drafting of laws and regulations for securities markets. To study and formulate the principles, policies and rules related to securities markets. To formulate development plans and annual plans for securities markets. To direct, co-ordinate, supervise and examine matters related to securities in various regions and relevant departments. To direct, plan and co-ordinate test operations of futures market.
5. To exercise centralized supervision of securities business.

Mr. Zheng Zeguang, born in Guangdong Province, was the Deputy Chief of Mission of Embassy of People's Republic of China in the USA. After graduating from Punning Teacher Training College, Minister Zheng taught for two years in a middle school in Guangdong. He later went to South China Normal University and graduated with a degree of Bachelor of Arts. In 1986, Minister Zheng studied International Law in the University of Wales, UK and from 1987 on, he worked in the Chinese Embassy in Trinidad & Tobago.

Minister Zheng was deputy director in the Department of North America & Oceania Affairs in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and later worked in the Chinese Embassy in Washington, DC. From 1999 to 2004, he was director of U.S. Affairs and deputy director-general in the Department of North America & Oceania Affairs, Ministry of

Foreign Affairs, People's Republic of China.

Over the years, Minister Zheng attended various training programs organized by Ministry of Foreign Affairs and other institutions, including a senior executive program co-organized by the prestigious Qinghua University and Harvard University.
