Principles

- 1. Post activity/event reflection is an essential part of Scouting education where the method of delivery is through 'Learning by Doing'.
- 2. Such reflections should be conducted as soon as the activity is completed so as to capture the learning points and concretise the experience.
- 3. Reflections should articulate feelings and experience as well as key take-aways. This should ideally be referenced from the educational objectives of the activity completed.
- 4. The following questions are non-exhaustive and Rover/RSL may modify it to suit the needs of the activity and the Rover.
