



TRANSPORTATION PROCEDURES FOR 2021/2022 SCHOOL YEAR

2021-2022 Procedures

1. Fraser Public Schools does and will continue to provide hand sanitizer for bus all riders. Hand sanitizer dispensers are installed on every bus. All riders must use hand sanitizer when entering the bus.
2. Fraser Public Schools will continue to require that all riders wear an approved face mask while on our busses. This is for all events including field trips. See CDC recommendations.

3. Fraser Public Schools will encourage social distancing, as much as possible, while riding the bus.
 - Seating charts will continue and be followed. Seating charts are extremely important for contact tracing.
 - Students from the same household or living unit will be encouraged to sit together.
 - Encourage families to drop off children at school using their own cars, or walking to school, if feasible, which creates less demand for riding the bus and lowers the risk of children inter-mingling in confined spaces.
4. Fraser Public Schools will CONTINUE to use our battery operated handheld electrostatic sprayers with Hillyard QT3 to sanitize the bus twice a day. Once after our morning runs and once following our afternoon runs. Unless, there is a positive case or outbreak on a bus. We will then sanitize that bus according to the following conditions:
 - **If less than 24 hours have passed** since the person who is sick or diagnosed with COVID-19 has been on the bus, clean and disinfect the space.
 - **If more than 24 hours have passed** since the person who is sick or diagnosed with COVID-19 has been in the space, cleaning is enough. You may choose to also disinfect depending on [certain conditions](#) or everyday practices required by your facility.

- **If more than 3 days have passed** since the person who is sick or diagnosed with COVID-19 has been in the space, no additional cleaning (beyond regular cleaning practices) is needed.
5. Fraser Public Schools will, weather permitting, keep doors and windows open when cleaning the vehicle to let the vehicles thoroughly air out.
 6. Fraser Public Schools will, weather permitting, encourage drivers to open windows while driving to keep airflow moving.
