

# AUDITIONS

for the 2026-2027 LCHS Mainstage and Music Theater Ensemble  
will be held on **Tuesday, April 28th** in the  
LCHS Chorus/Theatre Classroom, 3:45-5:30 PM

## **Audition Requirements:**

- **Prepare a monologue (one minute in length)** that shows a character in great contrast to yourself. *Monologues must be memorized!* Please bring a copy of the monologue with you.
  - Please do not just stand and recite. I want to see you IN character. *Please do not choose a monologue from a movie or TV show.* It must be from a play, or just a stand-alone monologue.
  - Energy, projection, diction, and confidence are important!
  - You may be asked to make adjustments to your performance on the spot, so don't rehearse it only one way. For example, I may ask you to try again with a totally different emotion.

- **Prepare about 17 measures (30 seconds) of a song of your choice.** This will be sung without accompaniment. Songs from musicals are preferred, but not required.
  - I may lead you in some vocal exercises to hear your range.
  - I may ask you to sing the song in a different key. Be prepared to be flexible.
  - *Do not* worry if singing is not your strong point! If you are a strong actor, we can work on the singing.

Mainstage is 4th block Semester 1\*, Music Theatre Ensemble is 4th block Semester 2. Both classes require about 2 months of daily after-school rehearsals, as well as some weekends. Mainstage is the class that performs the competition one-act.

\*There will be a very limited number of open slots in Mainstage next year.

# MAINSTAGE/MUSIC THEATER ENSEMBLE AUDITION PARENT CONSENT

My child, \_\_\_\_\_, has permission to audition for Mainstage and/or Music Theater Ensemble for the 2026-2027 school year. I understand that this class meets during 4<sup>th</sup> block and is a full credit, graded course. I also understand that this class involves an after-school time commitment that is part of the requirements of the course. I understand that, should my child be chosen for a spot in one or both of these classes, he/she will be expected to:

- Attend after-school rehearsals, eventually every day (until 6:00). These rehearsals usually begin after the first 4 weeks of the semester. They will start off as 2-3 times/week and will become a daily requirement as we get closer to performance weekends. *We usually rehearse every day after school and every other Saturday for about 6 weeks.*
- Attend occasional Saturday rehearsals
- Full participation in all performances
- Have transportation available
- Provide some of his/her own costume pieces, which may require some purchases (no more than \$50 per show, typically)
- Have excellent attendance at all rehearsals, including those during the school day. This class is from 1:45-3:20. Medical/dental appointments should not be made during this time or during after-school rehearsals.

Please explain any potential conflicts below:

I understand that an inability to satisfactorily meet the expectations listed above may mean that my child will not be granted a spot in the class, or that he/she may lose his/her spot should conflicts arise between the time of auditions and the start of the semester.
