Sending a Letter

Sending letters to leaders, lawmakers and politicians is critical to spreading awareness of world federalism amongst decision-makers. To send a letter, follow these steps:

Mailing a Letter

- 1. Find the physical address of your recipient.
- 2. Copy the text below into a word document for printing.
- 3. Format the letter using formal letter rules. (English rules here.)
- 4. Print and sign your name.
- 5. Take a photo of your letter and share it with the Young World Federalists.
 - a. Note: Do not include your address in the photo!
- 6. Address the envelope and place it in the mailbox. (Tips here.)
- 7. Share any response with the Young World Federalists.

Emailing a Letter

- 1. Find the email address of your recipient.
- 2. Copy the text below into an email.
- 3. Fill in your name and the name of your recipient.
- 4. Send the email.
- 5. Screenshot your email and share it with the Young World Federalists.
 - a. Note: Do not include your email in the screenshot!
- 6. Share any response with the Young World Federalists.

Sample Letter Text

I am writing to you today as a supporter of the Young World Federalists, a global movement building support for world federalism. I am asking for your support for reform of the United Nations Environmental Program and the International Criminal Court to prosecute crimes against the environment, take effective action on climate change, and build a sustainable global economy.

The Young World Federalists envision a world run by humanity, for humanity, providing equal opportunity to all on a thriving planet. We are shocked and disappointed by the empty promises to curb carbon emissions and protect biodiversity and urge you to speak out against the failure of the international system to address the greatest challenge of our time.

Breaking the pattern of countries failing to act for the common good requires a global authority with the power and legitimacy to negotiate and enforce binding agreements.
