Introduction

(Calibri 14, bold, 1 space, space before 12 pt, space after 6 pt)

(Calibri 12, 1 space). The introduction contains adequate background and followed by references related to the topic. Present a clear "state of the art" and "gap analysis," why the research is important, and the theoretical concept behind it. A brief general background can be included in this article. Objectives of research are written at the end of the introduction. The name of the organism written with the common or local name must be followed by the Latin name for the first writing, for example, *Nilaparvata lugens* Stal 1854 (Hemiptera: Delphacidae), then author can use one of them. A standard citation application is recommended to refer to and cite references (for example, Mendeley), which is then adapted to the JPT style.

Methods

(Calibri 12, 1 space). This section provides detailed and precise information, which allows other researchers to repeat this research. If the method used refers to a previously published technique, the author should mention the source of the reference. Any modifications to the method used should also be explained. Describe the research design, such as procedures, surveys, interviews, parameters observed, statistical analysis, etc. All chemicals or supporting tools must be written down, followed by material specifications, units, and other important information.

Sub Title

(Calibri 12, 1 space). Each research process must be written in detail by including the unit of observation. Calculations must be accompanied by a formula written using the equation application, allowing the editor to rearrange the equation.

Results

(Calibri 14, bold, 1 space, space before 6 pt, space after 6 pt)




Figure 1. Colony diameter of entomopathogenic fungi isolates 1-7 days after incubation (Calibri 12, 1 space)

(Calibri 12, 1 space). Results and discussion should be written separately and presented sequentially from the primary data to the supporting data. Each result shown here must be explained the procedure first in the research method. Each result should not appear suddenly without being explained in advance in the research method. Tables and figures are placed directly in their proper position, as needed. The table is made in open form, given a title above it. There is no obligation to choose the color of photos/images/graphics if the article is only intended for online publication. However, if the author wants a hard copy, the images are recommended in black and white (because there is an additional fee of IDR 500,000 or \$35/exemplar if it is in color). The title of the image is written below the image. Information under tables/photos/images/graphics is written in the letters Calibri 10. The following is an example of making tables and graphs (Table 1, Figure 1).

The numbers in the same column followed by the same letter are not significantly different according to DMRT at the 5% level of significance (Calibri 10).

Refrain from repeating all data from tables or figures in the text. Present only the data's findings or the trends and describe the new and important aspects of the



study. Only reveal information based on the results, not others or own opinions. Indicate the limitations of the research. Write down any new or unsolved problems for the future.

Discussion

(Calibri 14, bold, 1 space, space before 6 pt, space after 6 pt)

(Calibri 12, 1 space). The discussion is well presented by discussing all the results, individually and generally. The author must discuss the relation between the findings and the basic concepts or hypotheses. The author must also disclose whether arguments are necessarily related to other works by other researchers. Write down the implications of the results regarding the theory or application.

Conclusion

(Calibri 14, bold, 1 space, space before 6 pt, space after 6 pt)

(Calibri 12, 1 space). It is written in one paragraph, briefly and clearly. Conclusions should link to the title and the objective. Do not make statements that are not supported by research data. Write a contribution to the development of science in general. Refrain from further discussing the conclusions, repeating the abstract, or restating the results.

Additional Explanation

Cite reference published in the last 10 years. Every reference referred to and appeared in the text (author, year) must be written in the references. In citing an article written by two authors, both last names must be mentioned, for example, **Habazar and Yanti (2017)** or **(Habazar and Yanti, 2017)**.

To cite an article written by three or more authors, only the last name of the first author is mentioned, followed by **et al.** Writing **et al.** marked with a comma if followed directly by the year of publication. If the year is in parentheses, **et al.** is not followed by a comma. The writing of **et al.** is not italicized; for example, **Lina et al. (2012)** or **(Lina et al., 2012)**.

Information indicated by the word "cit" or originating from anonymous sources **should be avoided**. References to unpublished data and personal communications are not shown in the references but must be written directly in the text, for example, **(Rifai, 2007, personal communication)** or **(Setyawan, 2007, unpublished data)**.

The reference is written alphabetically without numbering. The last name of the first author is placed at the front. For other authors, it is normally written, but the first and middle names are abbreviated. The title of each reference is not italicized and is written in lowercase unless there is needed, such as place name. The journal's name must be written in full, not italicized, and should not be abbreviated. All references originating from online journals must reveal the **DOI number**.
