

7 Cool Design Ideas for a Winter Sun Room

Choose One Decoration Theme and Stick to It

These power sockets can be used to power your lamps, heaters, or even to plug in your phone charger. Place at least one power socket near your sitting area for a more comfortable experience.

Optimise the Sunroom Lighting

A sunroom will not be complete without some lighting, natural or otherwise. If you have just started planning to build your sunroom, try to include tall glass windows to allow the entry of as much sunlight as possible.

You can also choose to bring more lighting into your sunroom by equipping it with [different types of light](#). Choose between standing lamps, ceiling or wall fixtures to go with your room's furnishing style.

Create a Reading Space

You don't need to have one full bookshelf extending from the floor to the ceiling, but you can have a small shelf or rack filled with a few of your favourite books.

You can even make your reading corner cozier by placing a coffee table right by the couch. If you don't have much use for a reading space, you can replace this with an office extension instead.

Keep the Room Looking Fresh with Plants

Decorate your room with plants to give your winter sunroom a natural look. Succulents may be an excellent choice to plant and nurture for the cold temperatures. Alternatively, you may consider planting plants such as tiger lilies, hibiscus, orchids and other flowering plants.

Pay Attention to the Smaller Furnishing Pieces
