

STUDENT SAFETY

The district shall provide for the safety of its students through close supervision in all school buildings and on all school grounds and through special attention to the following:

1. Maintaining a safe school environment. Safety experts shall be called in periodically to inspect the physical condition of all buildings and grounds.
2. Emphasizing of safe practices on the part of the school personnel and students, particularly in those areas of instruction or extracurricular activities, which offer special hazards.
3. Offering safety education to students as germane to particular subjects, such as science, industrial arts, homemaking, art, health and physical education.
4. Providing first-aid care for students in case of accident or sudden illness.
5. Establishing and enforcing rules and regulations designed to protect the safety of students and staff while in or on school property.
6. Providing safe vehicles for transporting eligible students to and from school or to and from school sponsored events.

The Director of Maintenance, Operations and Transportation shall work with the building principals to develop safety regulations pertinent to the above policies as well as other ways in which student safety requires special supervision and school protection.
