



## **POSITION: Senior Project Manager (Category 1)**

### **1. Objective(s) and Linkages to Reforms**

The Recovery and Reform Support Team (RST) at the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine (MoES) is a group of Ukrainian professionals (non-civil servants) funded on a temporary basis by donors to provide targeted technical support and assist the Ministry in the design and implementation of recovery and reform priorities. The RST assists in filling capacity gaps in the design and implementation of priority reform strategies and programmes while strengthening links and partnerships between the Ministry's priorities and relevant donor support.

The RST is part of the Ukraine Recovery and Reform Architecture Programme (URA), a comprehensive technical assistance programme deployed by the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (EBRD), in partnership with the European Union, to support critical recovery and reform processes in Ukraine.

The RST assists the MoES in the implementation of priority education reforms in the following areas: Vocational Education and Training (VET), as well as Public Administration Reform (PAR) and Digital Transformation of Education.

### **2. Position and Reporting Lines**

The Senior Project Manager will report to the RST Director and will maintain close coordination and collaboration with the relevant Deputy Minister and the Director-General of the Digital Transformation Directorate.

### **3. Duration and Proposed Timeframe**

The consultancy appointment is expected to start in June 2026. Duration of the assignment is subject to the availability of project funding, the consultant's performance, and the specific requirements of the RST. The probation period is two months.

### **4. Main Duties, Responsibilities and Deliverables**

The Senior Project Manager will support the Ministry in further development of the All-Ukrainian School Online (AUSO) as a national digital learning platform, with a particular focus on strengthening the connection between upper secondary (specialised) education and the vocational education and training (VET) system through competency-based content and structured learning pathways.

The Senior Project Manager will be responsible for:

- managing the planning and implementation of AUSO development projects, including those supporting upper secondary education aligned with VET priorities
- coordinating the development of high-quality educational content, with a focus on career-oriented and pre-vocational modules for upper-secondary school students
