

# Abstract Submission Guidelines for MJVC 2024

Please follow the guidelines below when preparing an abstract for oral and poster presentation. For participants who are interested in submitting a full paper, the same abstract will be used for submission via EquinOCS.

## Conference topic:

MJVC 2024 welcomes submissions across various disciplines, divided into a few tracks:

- Track 1: Science and Technology,
- Track 2: Social Sciences and Humanities,
- Track 3: Law, Economy and Business,
- Track 4: Engineering, Manufacturing, and Construction,
- Track 5: Health and Medicine,
- Track 6: Cross-disciplinary and other emerging areas.

## Title

The title should be concise, and informative and should not be misleading. Please avoid abbreviations and punctuation.

## Authors and affiliations

Please provide the full names of the authors and underline the presenting author. The corresponding author(s) should be marked with an asterisk (\*) in the author list. Please provide the contact email address of the corresponding author(s).

Affiliations should be provided to the author's name with a superscript number. Please present the full address.

## Content

Your abstract should be **less than 350 words** on **one-page**. The major aspects of the abstract should include the overall purpose of the research, methodology, principal results and interpretations, and conclusion. A single pictorial summary (graphical abstract) showing the key findings is optional.

The submitted abstract should be in Microsoft Office Word file format (\*.doc, \*.docx). The abstract should not contain citations. Please submit the abstract electronically via the Google form. The file name should be written as Author's name\_Track no. (e.g., Shinji Watanabe\_Track 1).
