#### Statewide Investment to Expand Access to Career-Technical Education

#### Career Pathway Support Network

The Ohio Department of Education and Workforce, in collaboration with the Ohio Department of Higher Education, is transitioning the work of Ohio's Tech Prep Centers to Career Pathway Support Networks.

Backed by a two-year, \$7.1 million allocation, this initiative is designed to strengthen regional career-technical education infrastructure and ensure more Ohio students are prepared for in-demand careers. The RFA outlines a two-year funding strategy to provide mentoring to guide students, expose them to various professionals, and expand access to career-technical education.


Beginning **October 1, 2025**, Ohio's Tech Prep Regional Centers will transition to Career Pathway Support Networks. This transition will coincide with the addition of a seventh region to align with updates made by JobsOhio.
