Observations:

- Lower percentage of kids in SPED compared to the district despite higher number of kids of color - is the 8% accurate?
 - We should include disaggregation (SPED / Latinx / AA) in order to get a clearer picture
 - KIPP is an EI Dorado SELPA school
- When looking at cohort retention data (KIPP compared to K-8 school, and middle schools for 6-8)...
- Include cohort data into the library of data
- What happened in 2017? Scores went down
- KIPP Bayview math scores GRADE 5 are across the board significantly lower than SFUSD, except for the comparison schools are quite similar
- Do we keep data on the number of students that opt out of testing?
 - It's on the dashboard (performance indicator review)
- The numbers that are dashed out seem to not be consistent with what we know about these schools and their population
- What assessments are schools using to track growth and instruction?
 - It's included in the charter petition
