I am reaching out to share an exciting opportunity---from July 9–12, 2026, ISACC will host a four-day writing workshop entitled, “**Writing Biblically: ‘Making Every Thought Captive to Obey Christ’ in Society.**”

Designed for both professional and aspiring writers, Writing Biblically is ISACC's training course for those who seek to “make every thought (and writing) captive to obey Christ” while engaging the wider world. Participants will learn to write from a Christian perspective and integrate God's Word into the analysis of contemporary social and cultural issues.

The course will cover topics such as **Biblical Core Themes** and their application to complex issues, **Discipling the Mind**, the **Practice of New Media Technologies**, and the **Elements of Good Writing**. It will also provide opportunities for practical writing exercises, coaching, and peer critique.

We are honored to have Dr. Melba Padilla Maggay lead this workshop alongside fellow writer, anthropologist, and professor Dr. Miriam Adeney. Together, their decades of experience in writing and engaging a wide range of issues through both a Christian perspective and a social scientist's lens will provide participants with exceptional mentorship and guidance.

Frequently Asked Questions

Is this a face-to-face or online workshop?

This is a 4-day, stay-in, face-to-face workshop to be held at Silong 47 East (Loyola Heights, Quezon City).

Can I opt not to stay in?

No. Participants are required to stay at the venue to fully engage in the workshop. Evening sessions are dedicated to reflection and writing, with outputs presented the following morning for feedback from resource speakers and fellow participants. Staying off-site may lead to distractions that could affect your learning experience.

How can I apply for the scholarship?
