Please note that all second year U17 riders moving into U19 as at 1 January 2026 are permitted to enter this event as per the Junior Riding-Up Policy.

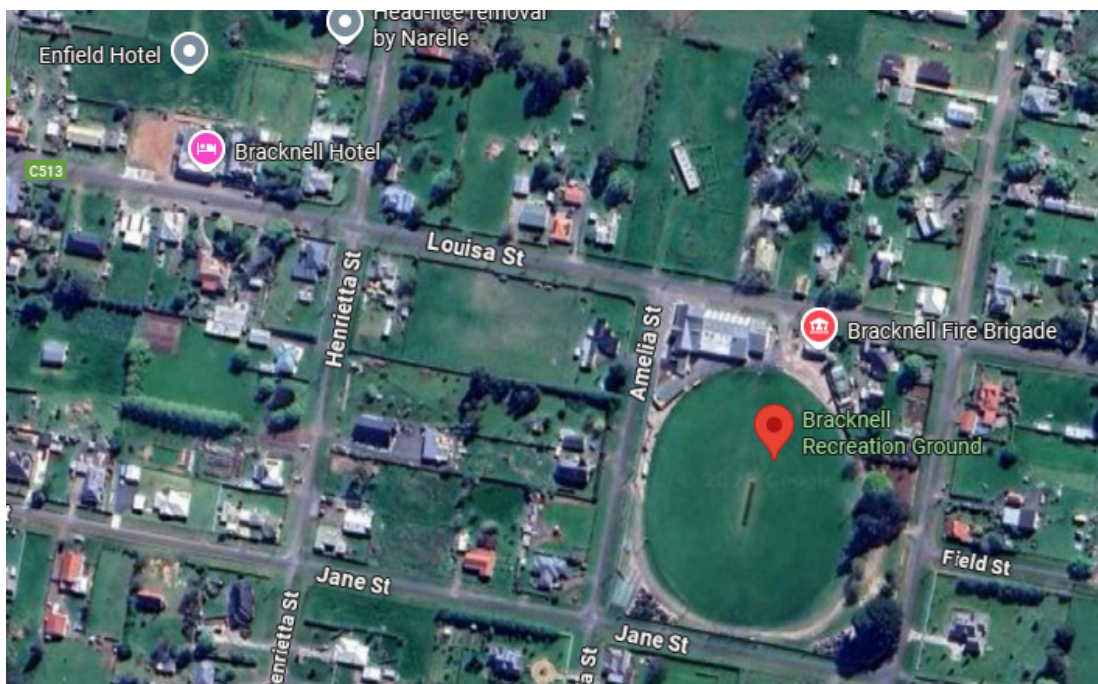

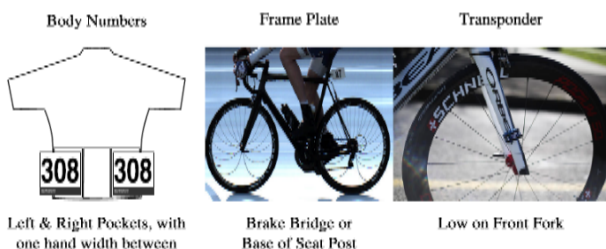
## Race Numbers

## State Championships

As there will be no spares car following - riders who have mechanical or other issues will not be given assistance by a following car or persons involved in race. Coaches or mechanics can attend the rider but no help to get rider back to a bunch or be given a lap out.

Rollout from Recreation Ground (Neutral zone)

Turn left onto Elizabeth St/Oaks Rd/C511 (Race Start)

Turn left onto Whitemore Rd/C507

Turn left onto Adelphi Rd/C510

Turn right to stay on Adelphi Rd/C510

Turn left onto Glenore Rd/C510

Turn left onto Cluan Rd/C505

Turn left onto Bracknell Rd/C513

Turn left onto Whitemore Rd/C507

Turn left onto Adelphi Rd/C510

Turn right to stay on Adelphi Rd/C510

Turn left onto Glenore Rd/C510

Turn left onto Cluan Rd/C505

Turn left onto Bracknell Rd/C513

Finish line 2.3k from Bracknell Rd left turn

## Feed / Litter Zone

A feed zone for U19/U23/Elite and Masters Men 1-4 riders will be set up at the Finish.

Riders will be able to feed and drop rubbish at the nominated feed zone. Any rubbish dropped will be the responsibility of the riders and their feeders to collect and place in bins.
