

Keyword list for TO – ZI119 (mDP)

This list is intended to have a standardized set of keywords to be used for the bibliographical entries and notes in the line TO (= TTopics). This is crucial to have an effective [“Topical index”](#).

NOTE: to divide multiple keywords in the TO line, please use a semi-colon (;); no other characters are detected by the MID (“Markdown Input to Display”) program.

Please:

- 1) add in the present list all the keywords you use (please follow the alphabetical order and adjust the numbering accordingly);
- 2) before adding a new keyword, please check if that has been already entered here, either in the same or similar form.

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¹ Please note that you can use some “tricks” in order to have a more targeted keywords; I list here just some examples:

- 1) topic A (major) ; topic B (where B is a further specification of topic A, as a sub-class); e.g.: “politics: power”;
- 2) topic A (topic B, where B is a further specification of topic A, as a sub-class) ; e.g.: “politics (power)”;
- 3) “doubled topic” (allowing a manual double search): topic A: topic B ; topic B: topic A (cf. 1 for A and B); e.g.: “politics: power; power: politics”;
- 4) topic B (wider category, even if less important) ; topic A (major category); e.g.: “power: politics”;
- 5) topic A **of/in** (other prepositions are allowed) topic B; e.g.: “power **in** politics”.
