



Position: Voter Outreach and Engagement Street Team members

Position Hours and Timeline: June-November 2023. About 4-8 hours per week. Hours are flexible but availability in the late afternoon - early evening and up to two weekend days per month is strongly preferred.

Compensation: \$20-\$22/hr based on experience

Summary:

Lowell Alliance's Voter Outreach and Engagement Street Team will work closely with Lowell Votes to develop and carry out an outreach strategy to: 1. Inform the community of important election related deadlines and how to vote 2. Register new voters and provide information on candidates and their stance on issues important to the community 3. Remind and inform the community on the new voting districts and system that was implemented in 2021.

Lowell Alliance is a member of the Lowell Votes coalition and our street team's work will be done in support of the coalition's goals. Lowell Votes is a community-based, non-partisan, grass-roots initiative to increase voter participation in Lowell, Massachusetts. We aim to increase voter access particularly for minority and under-engaged voters and advocate for local government transparency and accountability.

Specific duties and task

- Attend trainings on best practices for engaging the public, explaining Lowell's new voting system and districts, and mobilizing voters.
- Register new voters through tabling in public spaces
- Distribute voting information to Lowell residents on the candidates running and their stance on issues important to the community including flyering in businesses, door knocking, and phone-banking

Qualifications:

- Fluency in English and one or more of the following languages: Spanish, Portuguese, Khmer
- Strong verbal communication skills
- High comfort level going door-to-door and speaking with people over the phone about voting-related issues.



- Interest in and some knowledge of civic engagement, voter education, voter mobilization etc.
- Familiarity with Lowell and connections to the community are strongly preferred
