Treasurer's Report - Brian Coughlin

1. MLL Account update
 - a. Around \$50k in total income
 - b. Spring in-house costs the league \$236.94 per player (335 registered players in spring)
 - i. We can cut some expenses in certain areas, but it would yield minimal savings
2. Travel Account update
 - a. \$216 per player (uniforms, hats, etc.)
3. Fundraising, snack stand, etc. are bringing in needed income.
