College Credit Opportunities

Students enrolled at Lutheran High may be able to get an early start on completing a college program by participating in a dual credit program. *Students should be aware that Lutheran High cannot guarantee the transferability of these college credits to the institution of the student's choice.* All schools cooperating with Lutheran High have regional accreditation, verifying the validity of the credit earned. Transferability of credit is determined by the institution receiving the credit, not by the institution that originally issued it. Therefore, students should check with colleges of interest to determine the transferability of these credits.

If you search "Transfer Guide" on the college website you are interested in attending, you can typically find the credits they are willing to accept from various institutions. You may also reach out to the registrar of that institution before enrolling in a dual credit program.

Dual Credit Programs

Dual Credit programs offer the opportunity to receive college credit for courses taught by LHS teachers at Lutheran High School. Lutheran High School participates in several dual credit programs offered through area universities. There is a fee for the college credit paid by the student directly to the college for each course. Details regarding registration procedures, fees, and deadlines are covered in the specific classes where dual credit is available. Students are personally responsible for making sure all deadlines are met.

The list of courses offered for college credit may vary from term to term, due to factors beyond the control of LHS, and may not be determined until the start of the school year. Courses that may offer college credit and their corresponding university course numbers are indicated in the course descriptions. Parents with questions regarding deadlines for specific classes are encouraged to contact their child's counselor at the start of each term.

Additionally, before each school year, students can apply through the Student Services office to utilize up to one block each semester of their junior and/or senior year to take an online dual enrollment course. If approved by LHS student services, students are responsible for enrolling in the course they wish to take. Students should ensure this class is offered asynchronously so that other class times are not interrupted.

To be eligible for these courses, students must be juniors or seniors with a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 - 3.0 or higher, depending on the college offering the credit. Because these classes are part of the regular LHS curriculum, grades for these classes are recorded as regular high school classes and are included in the student's cumulative GPA. Students are responsible for contacting the universities and requesting a college transcript of their coursework.

Registration Process:

***A representative from MBU will be at LHS to work with students through the registration process. Please wait for further information from that presentation before proceeding.

1. Visit [MBU ECP Registration - Missouri Baptist University \(Mobap\)](#).
2. Complete Form 1 of the registration process. You need to enter a parent or guardian's email and select your courses.
3. Your parent/guardian must check their email to access the link to Form 2 MOBAP.EDU. This step must be completed to be eligible to earn college credit upon completing the course. Otherwise, you are NOT registered.
4. Your form will be routed to the coordinator at your high school for approval. Once approved, confirmation emails will be sent to you. Please check this email carefully for accuracy.
5. Within 4-6 weeks, you will receive your bill through the US mail. Instructions for payment will be included.

1. Apply to Concordia University Nebraska to obtain a Concordia Student ID (J#)
 - a. cune.elluciancrmrecruit.com/Apply/Account/Create?returnUrl=%2FApply
 - b. If you have already applied, locate your J# (sent to your email address).
 - c. Can't find it? Email dualcredit@cune.edu.
2. Create a new student account or log in at cune.DualEnroll.com.
 - a. If you have your J#, then create your new DualEnroll account. OR
 - b. If you already have a DualEnroll account, then just log in.
3. After entering your Student Information, Terms and Conditions, FERPA Consent, Parent Information, and High School information, then it's time to Select Courses!
4. Select the course(s) you wish to take that are offered at your school.
5. Check with your instructor to make sure they have confirmed you have selected the correct course or section.
6. Once the instructor confirms you, a link will automatically be sent via email/text to the parent who is responsible for providing consent and payment. The cost for dual credit courses through Concordia is \$90/credit hour. (i.e. a 3-hour course=\$270). Using a credit card, parents will pay for each course individually. There is also a small processing fee.
7. Check with your parents to make sure they have received the request. Please contact dualcredit@cune.edu if you need assistance.
8. Once consent is given and payment is received, you are registered! Please pay close attention to the registration details and deadlines.
9. PLEASE NOTE!! There can be a 48-hour delay between the first and second parts of the CUNE registration process. Students MUST start this process at least 3 days before the deadline.

1. Create or update the DualEnroll account, access from <https://missouristate.dualenroll.com/login>
2. Select course(s) for dual credit.
3. Parent/guardian consent. Registration will not be considered complete until the parent/guardian's consent is provided. Payment is not required at the time of registration. The payment option is selected at this time. The parent/guardian will receive an email with a link to provide consent for each course the student requests. (Check your spam or junk mail for this message from DualEnroll.)
4. Confirmation of registration is sent to the parent/guardian and the student.

Ensuring Your Dual Credits Appear on Your College Transcript

In order for these classes to count on your college record, you MUST request that an OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT be sent to the college or university that you will be attending from each credit-granting institution. Our suggestion is to request these transcripts after you complete your senior year at LHS. Below is a list of links by school to help you request these transcripts. Please be aware that there is typically a cost associated with the request of a transcript from each college.
