Student Arrival & Dismissal

Doors open/Parent Drop off starts at 8:05am Students go to homeroom or eat breakfast before 8:35am School day & Morning Meeting start at 8:35am Late students sign in the office after 8:35am

Dismissal 3:00-3:15 pm

Students must come to school with a plan for dismissal (walker, bus, pick-up)

There will be many different announcements to let you know when to leave the school.

Buses are called in groups of 6-8. Each classroom has a system to keep track of which buses have been called. ASK for HELP if you get confused!

Some students miss their buses every now and then. If you do, stay calm, and go to the office to call a family member. The administrators and secretaries will help you.



Important Information

Homeroom/Lockers

Students report to their homeroom at the beginning & end of each day. Lockers are sometimes used to store bags or coats at arrival or dismissal. Your homeroom teacher will tell you how and when they are used. You do not need a lock for your locker.

Homework

Homework is given each night and usually expected that it will be completed the next day.

Grade 5 – 50 minutes per night (on average) Grade 6 – 60-90 minutes per night (on average)

What if I forget my homework?

Middle school is all about learning how to be more responsible and independent. Students who do not do their homework will be expected to make it up. Sometimes students will make it up during lunchtime or they will complete it at home and bring it in the following day. Students who continue to struggle with completing homework on time will be provided with other supports to help them become more responsible.

Technology

Cell phones and smart watches are not allowed to be worn or carried during the school day. If they are brought to school, they are to be put in their bag or locker for the day. Students are expected to bring their iPad to school each day fully charged. Your teachers will help you learn how to use them.

Frequently Asked Questions

What does the school look like? Will I get lost?

The school has three levels, but most classrooms are on the second and third level. The teachers are there to help you out if you get lost. Your teachers, especially in the beginning, will walk your class wherever you need to go. Notice the signs around the building to help lead you in the right direction.

What is the 6-day cycle?

Some classes meet every day, like Math, Science, ELA, Social Studies, and Allied Arts. Other classes meet twice every six what a schedule might look like.

Teaming at Sherwood Middle School

When you arrive at Sherwood, you will be assigned to a team.


Teams are close communities at Sherwood. You will get to know the people on your team and in your *neighborhood* really well. Each team is made up of two team teachers and about 45-50 students. Each team is identified by a color (5 Purple, 6 Blue). Each team has an English Language Arts/Social Studies Teacher and a Math/Science Teacher, along with a special education teacher and instructional aide. Your ELA/SS or Math/Science teacher also serve as homeroom teachers.



Physical Education

Students have Phys Ed. twice every six days. Usually students change for PE class. Students who have PE class are expected to wear sneakers, shorts or sweatpants and a t-shirt for this class.





Lunch

Students have many choices of food options at lunch. Students have the choice to buy their lunch, or bring their lunch from home. Students each lunch with their team but will also eat lunch with 2-3 other teams from their grade level.
