## Description of learning experience and assessment opportunities

***Listening and Talking:*** Sequence the story using large pictures from the story and take the class outside to organise the pictures in the order of the story (beginning, middle, end). Can be carried out in a classroom but much more space and freedom to move around outside.

***Reading:*** Take the story outside and read the story to the children, consider where the best place in your playground would be for a goldfish to take a vacation...is there one?

*Writing:* Using chalk, draw a goldfish bowl and fish where pupils think would be a good place for a vacation (playground/their garden/local park) and take a photo. Using the photo mark make/annotate/word mat so children can write a sentence/choose a word as to why that is a good place for a vacation.
