Re: Reviewing the Public Lighting Code of Practice

On behalf of our members, the Victorian Greenhouse Alliances (VGAs) are pleased to provide this response to the Essential Services Commission (ESC) review of the Public Lighting Code (the Code).

The VGAs are formal partnerships of local governments and statutory agencies driving climate change action across Victoria's municipalities. The VGAs deliver regional mitigation and adaptation programs that provide economies of scale and enable projects typically beyond the reach of individual councils and agencies. Our project work is complemented by targeted advocacy, capacity building and regional partnerships.

Further to our discussions with you on 5 August 2025, we welcome the review of the Code and the steps the ESC have taken to proactively engage with the Australian Energy Regulator (AER) following our response to the Victorian Electricity Distribution Price Review 2026-31.¹ The Code is clearly out of date due to technology changes, which impacts the operation and management of street lighting. Updating the Code is important, as it remains a key method by which the Distribution Network Service Providers (DNSPs) and the AER test the assumptions within the DNSPs' regulated pricing models.

We support the ESC's proposal to revoke the Code and transfer the relevant obligations to the Electricity Distribution Code of Practice as set out in the *Appendix B draft mark-up* on the Engage Victoria website.² To streamline and simplify the feedback process, we have provided comments and proposed additional minor changes in the attached (*Appendix B marked-up draft VGA Comments*).

We would welcome the opportunity to speak with you directly regarding this submission and address any clarifications or outstanding questions.
