

Endicott College – Study Abroad Equivalency Guide

Dear Colleagues:

The link at the bottom of this page will take you to a table with suggested Endicott course equivalents for courses that are offered at study abroad sites we typically send students to.

To use the table linked below, you could:

- Use the EC columns on the left to find a course/area and then scroll to the right to see sites that have offerings that could match that course/area of study
- Use the site headings across the top to navigate to a specific school you are considering, and then scroll down to see which areas of study/courses that university has offerings in

DISCLAIMERS

1. These are **only SUGGESTIONS** for equivalencies – this is not an official document that provides rules for how to process study abroad credit. These recommended equivalencies come from deans' reviews of course descriptions, their experience processing these credits, and in trying to be consistent. School deans have the discretion to decide on transfer equivalencies, and may deviate from this chart when appropriate.
2. This table has no information about **when courses will be offered** at the various sites, so you will need to consult those schools to get information about their offerings for a particular semester
3. In some cases, more than 1 course from a school has been identified as counting for the same EC course, and courses without any known matches are likely mapped to XXX Elective credit.
4. Before using the info in this chart, please **confirm that catalog details** from the home institution are accurate, and verify that EC course details are correct by looking at the [current catalog](#) and current listing of [GenEd/WD/DEI designated courses](#).
