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Las April 10, Monday, Karen Davila had an interview in ANC's Headstart with former Department of Agriculture Under Secretary, Maia Halmen Valdez as she tries to clear her name from all the allegations of corruption involved in her firing as DA USEC. In this interview, Valdez said that it was because of the allegations of National Food Authority Administrator, Jason Aquino that these allegations started. Aquino was said to malign her credibility and her personal aspects of her life. She (Valdez) showed a letter to Davila and her viewers where Aquino accuses her of working with Jomerito "Jojo" Soliman, a notorious rice trader in creating a rice cartel in the country. Aquino was also said to have maligned her (Valdez') family by saying that Valdez' mother is sleeping with another man outside of her marriage.

As these allegations made by former USEC Maial Halmen Valdez against NFA Administrator Jason Aquino are undeniably heavy and confidential, Headstart constantly tried to contact Aquino for a statement and a chance to reason out and/or clear his name. Although, Aquino was not available for an immediate phone interview, it is evident that Headstart practiced this specific provision of the Philippine Press Institute Journalists' Code of Ethics:

Air all sides to a conflict.
