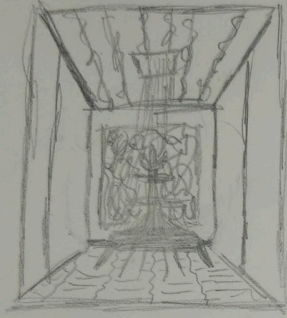


"The Original Olive Garden" Proposal

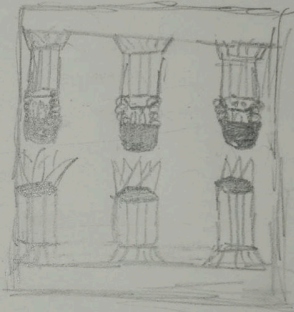
I was inspired by Classical Greek architecture and biophilic design, and I would like to fuse the two for an interesting result. I would like to have a small Greek-style temple built halfway into the side of a hill to help regulate the temperature. The front will stick out and contain columns that split in the middle to hold baskets and pots of flowers. The back wall will be built from glass to show the earthy materials and plants growing in the hillside. A hole in the ceiling will allow for rain collection which will be distributed out to various food gardens between walking paths. This will be both a decorative and functional home, and I could add a small bedroom/bathroom/kitchen area as a basement or extended ceiling space to make it more habitable.

Water Wheel spinning house ^{Waterfall}

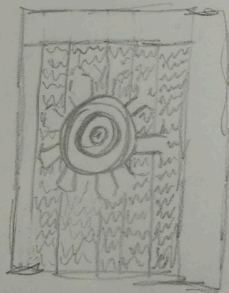

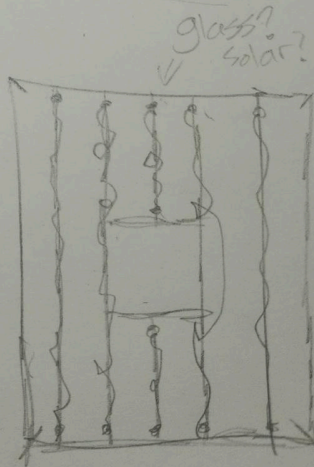
