The WIGTake exercise is designed to show the disparity between the existing state of Christianity in any given target and what is left to be done in the same target.

Question 1: How many people need to hear the gospel in your target? Demographics can help you get a realistic number. (eg. http://peoplegroups.org/ or http://www.thearda.com/)

Sociologists say when 10-25% of the population holds one view, it is commonly known by 100% (https://news.rpi.edu/luwakkey/2902). If 10-25% of your population has received the gospel than close to 100% of the population will know the gospel. We will use 10%.

Question 2: What is 10% of your target population?

Question 3: What is a reasonable number of people you would expect a disciple to share the gospel in a year?

Question 4: How many disciples do you know are sharing the gospel that often?

Question 5: How many years will it take to share the gospel with 10% of your target?

Depending on the population of your target and the number of disciples and the people they share with, your goal to reach your target people could be a pretty daunting task. For instance, Target A has 1.5 million lost people. There are 25 people who share the gospel 12 times a year. It would take 500 years to reach the people group. This doesn't even take into account the reception of the gospel and population growth.

Let's say we were training disciples to share 5 times a week and wanted to reach our target in 10 years.

Question 6: How many disciples would it take? (Click on the link for a simple calculator - Click Here)

We have found that in order to maintain a healthy momentum in sharing the gospel the disciples must be a part of a church on mission. You also need churches for the 10% of the target population that you are trying to reach.

Church planting in the United States has been an expensive venture. "The average amount of funding for a new church plant for all networks was \$172,200."
