





Dear Centennial Family,

We are in search of 4th and 5th grade students who have an interest in applying to serve on our AAA School Safety Patrol at Centennial Elementary. The purpose of this patrol is to provide school-aged children an extra sense of safety and security when going to and from school each day.

School Safety Patrollers:

- Complete traffic safety training.
- Protect students from hazards of crossing roads and highways on their way to and from school.
- Assist bus drivers in safely transporting students to and from school
- Teach fellow students about traffic safety.
- Serve other leadership functions under the direction of school officials.

Duties:

Patrol members...

- → report to their designated a.m. post from 8:45-9:00 a.m. (*11:20-11:30 on Late Start Days)
- → report to their designated p.m. post from 3:30-3:45 p.m. or until traffic is gone.
- → who ride the bus to/from school will have designated posts that accommodate their bus schedule.
- → report in all weather conditions, unless deemed dangerous by Centennial staff (lower than 20 degrees).
- → attend monthly meetings for training and team building.

Meetings will be held from 8:15-8:50 a.m. on Fridays: First Term Dates: Sept. 5, Oct. 17, Nov. 14, Dec. 12, Jan. 9

Please review the following information prior to giving permission for application.

- → Students will need to have parent/family member's permission to apply.
- → Teachers will provide student recommendations.
- → Students will be required to answer short essay questions related to their interest in the role and why they believe they are a good candidate.
- → Members are selected for their leadership, courtesy, dependability, interest in the job, and attitude toward others. We are looking for those who exemplify all TRACK characteristics trust, respect, attitude, cooperation and keeping safe.
- → Members are expected to adhere to the Safety Patrol pledge:
 - ◆ I Promise to do my best to....
 - Report for duty on time.
 - Perform my duties faithfully.
 - Strive to always set a good example.
 - Obey my teachers and officers of the patrol.

- Report dangerous student practices.
- Strive to earn the respect of fellow students by being a leader with my words and actions.
- → To provide more students with the opportunity to participate, members will serve for one term (September-January), and may reapply if they continue to meet the requirements for the second term (January-May). There will be an additional application period in January for those who wish to serve during the second term. If a student serves during the first term and would like to be considered for the second term, they will also need to reapply.
- → The Safety Patrol follows an award/demerit system to ensure students maintain the high standards of the program. Students receiving several demerits for school or classroom discipline, being late or not showing up for duty assignments without notifying the team supervisor, or failing to adhere to the Safety Patrol Pledge may be temporarily suspended from the Patrol. If disciplinary action is necessary, your full cooperation will be appreciated.

Completed applications and essays are due no later than Monday, August 25th. Safety Patrol members will...

- be notified of their selection by Friday, August 29th by Mrs. Coniglio/Mrs. Denise.
 - attend the initial training meeting on Friday, September 5th.
- begin patrol duties the week of Monday, September 8th-Friday, September 12th
